CHAMPIONS LEAGUE

With 166 managers signed up this season The Champions League will have the full complement of 96 managers taking part with 16 Groups of 6. The top two will qualify for the Knock-Out Stage with the 3rd placed manager going into the New Life Cup.

Draw Information

Rules of the Draw:-

Managers will be placed into Pots based on where they finished in last Season's Super20 Leagues. POT A are the highest seeds going down to POT F for the lowest seeds.

Managers will be drawn out of each Pot the first team drawn out will go into Group A the next team into Group B. All the teams will be drawn out of POT A, after being drawn a number between 1 and 5 will be drawn to determine their Fixture number for the group. The process will then be repeated for each of the remaining POTS.

PYRAMID CUP

This season Pyramid Cup will have 70 managers entering the competition this season.

The field will be made up of 4 Managers from the Conference and all the managers in the Pyramid Leagues below.

The Group Stage will have 16 Groups. 6 Groups of 5 and 10 Groups of 4. The top two managers qualifying for the knock-out stage with the 3rd placed manager going into the New Life Cup.

Draw Information

Managers have been seeded based on where they finished in last season's Super20 Leagues. New Managers have taken their place according to when they signed up for the game.

Managers will be drawn out of each Pot the first manager drawn out will go into Group A the next team into Group B. All the teams will be drawn out of POT A, after being drawn a number between 1 and 5 (dependant on group) will be drawn to determine their Fixture number for the group. The process will then be repeated for each of the remaining POTS. Groups A - F will be the groups with 5 managers.

NEW LIFE CUP Information

2017-2018 sees the fifth season of the **'New Life Cup'**. The competition named after New Life FC who Fantasy Challenge sponsor, it also aptly named as it will be a contest for managers who finish 3rd in their Champions League Group and Pyramid Cup Group. These managers will qualify for this new competition.

The New Life Cup will be a knockout competition with a similar format to the Champions League and Pyramid Cup knock out stages, the competition will be over two legs until the final which will take place in Gameweek 38.

There is one thing to be aware that the 1st Round will have seedlings, with all Champions League managers kept apart, so each match in the First round will see a former Champions League manager take on a Pyramid Cup manager.

After this first round Managers will just go into a hat and be drawn out for the subsequent rounds.

FC CUP Information

With 166 managers taking part this season it means the following.

You need to be placed 90th or above in the Overall League in Gameweek 10 to avoid the Qualifying Round.

Managers placed 91st – 166th in Gameweek 10 will go into the Qualifying Round.

AWAY GOAL RULE VOTE

The knock-out stages of the Champions League, Pyramid Cup and New Life Cup have used the away goal rule to determine matches that have been drawn similar to actual football.

This has not been used many times over the systems but has been brought into play last season it was used several times.

The fact that there is no actual home advantage in Fantasy Football has brought the rule into question. So we are asking you the managers who play the game to vote on how you would like drawn matches in these three competitions to be decided.

Below are the three options with an explanation of how each one works:-

OPTION 1 AWAY GOALS

The first Option is not to make a change to the competitions. Whilst the away goal rule is the same as in real football it has to be said that in Fantasy football there is no advantage to the home manager. Of course a drawn in a cup competition has to be won. The away goal rule in Fantasy Football all come down to the draw you could argue the manager who knows he is away in the second leg knows what score he has to beat.

Last season the Away Goal rule came into play 3 times please see the examples below which show how it works. Examples :-

Champions League 2nd Round 1st Leg Stefan Rance 39 – 48 Rio Mclister 2nd Leg Rio McLister 31- 40 Stefan Rance Aggregate Stefan Rance 79 – 79 Rio McLister Rio McLister advanced scoring 48 points when he was away as opposed to Stefan Rance scoring 40

Champions League Semi-Final 1st Leg Hans Hayrynen 20 – 59 Darren Cullen 2nd Leg Darren Cullen 56 – 95 Hans Hayrynen Aggregate Hans Hayrynen 115 – 115 Darren Cullen Hans Hayrynen advanced scoring 95 points when he was away as opposed to Darren Cullen scoring 59 New Life Cup Quarter-Final 1st Leg Chris Yu 34 – 33 Marcus Hogwood 2nd Leg Marcus Hogwood 58 – 57 Chris Yu Aggregate 34 – 33 Marcus Hogwood Chris Yu Chris Yu advanced scoring 57 points when he was away as opposed to Marcus Hogwood scoring 33

OPTION 2 PENALTIES

To show how a penalty shoot-out happens in Fantasy Challenge I have used two new managers Gameweek 1 teams. Both Gary Osbrey and Peter Hayward scored 55 points so if this was a cup match that would go to a penalty Shoot-out see below the teams and how the shoot-out would unfold.

First thing to mention is that Peter Hayward played his bench boost which means his bench become a factor in the Shoot-Out

The 4th and 5th Kicks are not required Gary Osbrey would have won the shoot-out 3-0.

OPTION 3 REPLAY

Very simple if the two legged match ends in a draw a replay will happen the following gameweek. Of course if this match is then drawn it would have to go to penalties.

The real question is here is that should a match which has already had two legs go to a replay.

The way the season is worked out it will mean potentially that your team will be involved in 3 matches in one gameweek, in fantasy terms
