With the final Gameweek to take place we take a look at all the issues to be decided in the Super Twenty leagues. Are you involved?

## Terminology explained: -

**Lucky Promotion** – When a player has finished outside the promotion places but due to managers dropping out of the game in the higher division they can get promoted after the Lucky Survival (see below) places have been determined.

**Lucky Survival** – Now if a manager drops out of a Super Twenty Division the manager in 16<sup>th</sup> place (In a 20-team division) will be re-instated if more than one manager drops out this will continue until the 20<sup>th</sup> manager then managers in the lower league will receive a lucky promotion (See above).

**Rookie Season** – First season in Fantasy Challenge

### TITLE

Andy Taylor looking for his second title in XX season knows victor over already relegated Michael Lynn will deliver the title. If Taylor slips up Josph Shalome will need to beat Paul 'The Ledge' Dwinfour to take the tile. 'The Ledge' has already qualified for the Super20 Cup. If both Taylor and Shalome were to lose Kojo Amofa in his first season back after winning last season's Championship title could take the crown with victory over James Dwinfour who needs victory to be assured of staying up.

### SUPER20 QUALIFICATION

Roari Fox sits in 6<sup>th</sup> place 1 point clear of 9<sup>th</sup> victory over Andreas Themistocleous secures qualification. Themistocleous knows a win means he will climb above Fox but not necessarily secure qualification he will need other results to go his way. Glen Hogwood having just won the FC Cup needs a win against Rilwan Dwaodu to secure qualification. Dawodu needs to win to avoid relegation. Darren Cullen takes on Steve 'Shewy' Shew knowing that if Themistocleous wins he stands a great chance of claiming a place. 'Shewy' needs victory and other results

to go his way to avoid relegation. Omid Afzalalghom needs to beat Rob Gurney and hope other results go his way. Great history between these two managers who have qualified for the Super20 cup more times than any other manager. Ian Gredley two-time Premier League champion needs results of matches already ymentioned to go his way and then beat Andy Gurney who has already qualified to stand a chance. Steve Haley who has just lost the Fc Cup Final by a point has the biggest task he needs results to go his way and then beat already relegated Lee ferridge.

**RELEGATION**

James Dwinfour former Premier League Winner needs a victory and to hold onto his 50-point points difference advantage to stay up. Dwinfour has a difficult match against title chasing Kojo Amofa. Two-time champion Steve ‘Shewy’ Shew needs Dwinfour to lose knowing that victory will keep him up but he faces Darren Cullen who needs a win to secure a super20 Cup Qualification place. Rilwan Dwodu needs both Dwinfour & Shew to lose and gain victory over Gen Hogwood another manager needing a win to secure Super20 Cup Qualification.

Maris Cras will be hoping that Strack slips up and will then need to beat Oliver Shanks who has already been relegated. If this was to happen Cars would take the title by a single point.

#### PROMOTION RACE

Ben Alexander needs to beat Dan Jopp to secure promotion, Jopp is fighting relegation, Alexander can still be promoted if the four managers below all fail to win. Adrian Taylor occupies the last promotion place but needs victory over Andy McLaren, who is fighting relegation, to ensure promotion. Michael Carleton needs one of the two managers above him to slip and then beat Andrew Burchell who needs to win to stay up. David Pewtner needs two of the managers above him to slip up and then beat already relegated Darrell Jenkins. Sandeep Chohan trying to get back to the Premier League needs Three managers above him to slip and then take advantage with a win over Jatin Joshi who has nothing to play for. Dan Wyatt needs a miracle he needs the four managers above him to lose and he needs Adrian Taylor to be beaten by a big margin and needs a massive win himself over Hakan Bedir who is fighting promotion. Wyatt even results go his way needs a 134 Points Difference swing.

#### RELEGATION BATTLE

Andy McLaren looks comfortable due to points difference but to be sure of staying up he needs at least a draw against promotion chasing Adrian Taylor. Dan Jopp needs a win to be sure of survival he plays Ben Alexander who is chasing promotion. Stuart Shepherd also needs a win to be sure of survival against Matt Hansell who has nothing to play for. Hakan bedir needs one of the three managers above him to slip up and then beat Dan Wyatt who is chasing promotion. Andrew Burchell need to of the three managers above him to lose and to beat Michael Carelton who is fighting for promotion to survive.

Alistair Shields needs two of the managers above him to slip up and beat Rio McLister who is fighting relegation. For Shields a win and hope other results go his way.

### RELEGATION BATTLE

Jeff Aldersea needs a win against friend and former work colleague Thomas Lusty who is already relegated to stay up. Knowing this relationship there is nothing that Lusty would enjoy more than relegating his friend Aldersea. Tony Collins needs to beat Alvar Chambers who needs a win to stand a chance of promotion, Collins knows victory means he is safe. James Bastow needs one of Aldersea or Collins to slip up and beat the already promoted Steven McIntosh. Rio McLister faces promotion chasing Alistair Shields, Rio needs a win and two of Bastow, Collins and Aldersea to lose. Stephen Wilson is in the most precarious position needing three results to go his way and then he needs to beat Pete Cuckson who is chasing promotion. Still if all that criteria is met he needs two managers to lose by a big margin and needs a big win himself as point difference is against him against two of his rivals.

### TITLE RACE

David Noel needs to beat Dan Couch who is chasing promotion. Noel could potentially still be crowned champion on points difference if he loses. Eoin Mooney needs Noel to lose and then to beat Dipesh Gamanlal who has nothing to play for. If Noel slips up and Mooney wins, he needs a 13-point turnover in points difference. Hans Hayrynen can claim the title mathematically but he would need a miracle he needs Noel and Mooney to lose but big scores and then he needs to beat Lee Pepper who is fighting relegation. Hayrynen will require a 150+ points difference turnaround to take the title.

## PROMOTION RACE

Dan Couch needs a win over title chasing David Noel to secure promotion. Marc Bolton needs to beat Graham Price to secure promotion. Aubrey Davis really needs the two managers above him to slip up and then beat already relegated Jim Burrows, he could slip up if results do not go his way but would have to have a 43-points difference swing on Couch. Andrew Ogden needs the two managers directly above him to lose and then beat already relegated Steve Martin. Amanteer Singh Really needs the three managers directly above him to lose and beat already relegated Raymond Turp. Singh does have a potential points difference change if Ogden wins but will need to win by 50 points more than Ogdens victory. Sebastian Logan needs a minor miracle he needs the four managers directly above him to lose and then beat Alfie Harris who has nothing to play then he would be promoted.

## RELEGATION BATTLE

Mikki Mielonen and Dan Varrow are two points adrift of safety they meet on the final day meaning one of them should gain a victory moving the winner to 49 points, relegation will be confirmed for the manager that loses. The winner will then be hoping that one of Turner, Price or Pepper lose and they will have survived. Due to that almost relegation play off Ellie Turner needs a win against David Bardon who has nothing to play for to ensure survival, her terrible points difference meaning victory is essential. Graham Price needs a win against promotion chasing Marc Bolton to guarantee safety. Lee Pepper needs to beat title chasing Hans Hayrynen, Hayrynen really needs a miracle for the title and is already promoted victory for Pepper ensures survival. That match Mielonen against Varrow puts the pressure on Turner, Price and Pepper.

#### **TITLE RACE**

A two-horse race with both managers on the same points Kyle Berry currently lead on points difference 9 better than Daniel Hansen. So Berry needs to beat Don Heisser who is fighting relegation. Berry needs to win and beat the winning margin of Daniel Hansen if he wins to secure the title. Daniel Hansen takes on already relegated Joseph Lawrence needing to win and have a greater winning margin than Kyle Berry of 10 points to secure the title.

#### **PROMOTION RACE**

Kin Chau is 3 points clear of 6<sup>th</sup> and has a superior points difference of 47 but knows only victory against already relegated Stephen Loss secures promotion. Kieran Hogwood is in the last promotion place needing a victory over already promoted Nikki Ogden. Harrison Bath needs one of Chau or Hogwood to lose and then needs to win his match by a big score. He has a last day fixture against Bernard Aspell who has nothing to play for. If Bath can win and Chau loses, he needs a 47-points difference turnaround if Hogwood was to lose, he just needs a 12-points difference turnaround.

#### **RELEGATION BATTLE**

Marcus Hogwood holds 3 points lead of the relegation places but only a 20-point points difference advantage he needs to beat Ian Baldwin who has nothing to play for to ensure survival. Chad Pereira is just 2 points from safety so needs a victory over Daniel Turner who has already been relegated.
