Terminology explained: -

Lucky Promotion – When a player has finished outside the promotion places but due to managers dropping out of the game in the higher division they can get promoted after the Lucky Survival (see below) places have been determined. **Lucky Survival** – Now if a manager drops out of a Super Twenty Division the manager in 16th place (In a 20-team division) will be re-instated if more than one manager drops out this will continue until the 20th manager then managers in the lower league will receive a lucky promotion (See above).
