I have also not been able to go into great detail for the FC League.

With the final Gameweek to take place we take a look at all the issues to be decided in the Super Twenty leagues. Are you involved?

Terminology explained: -

Lucky Promotion – When a player has finished outside the promotion places but due to managers dropping out of the game in the higher division they can get promoted after the Lucky Survival (see below) places have been determined.

Lucky Survival – Now if a manager drops out of a Super Twenty Division the manager in 16th place (In a 20 team division) will be re-instated if more than one manager drops out this will continue until the 20th manager then managers in the lower league will receive a lucky promotion (See above).

7 out of the 10 fixtures have something riding on them.

Andreas Themistocleous needs victory in his last fixture to secure a super20 Cup place. His opponent Rilwan Dawodu has survived relegation by a quirk of fate on the final days fixtures which means he can't be passed by two of the four managers who can catch him. Steve Shew is the next manager that needs victory to secure a Super20 Cup qualification. 'Shewy' takes on the already relegated Paul Richardson. 'Shewy' is only in the Super20 cup places by virtue of points difference. James Dwinfour is on the same points as Steve Shew but is 81- points less in points difference he plays Roari Fox on the final day, Fox has already qualified for the Super20 Cup. Dave Sinclair is the next manager who is also on the same points as Steve Shew. Sinclair faces Ron Gurney another manager who has already qualified for the Supoer20 cup. Paul 'The Ledge' Dwinfour and Andy Taylor face each other on the final day both need victory and for other results to go their way to claim super20 Cup qualification. Victory for either will put them on 57 points meaning that they will need Steve Shew, James Dwinfour and Dave Sinclair to all lose or draw to gain qualification. With draws not happening that often this fixture between Paul 'The Ledge' Dwinfour and Andy Taylor does put, 'Shewy', Dwinfour and Sinclair under pressure.

The final day fixtures have thrown up two amazing matches in the relegation battle. The two managers currently in the relegation zone who can survive take on each other Glen Hogwood and Sandeep Chohan. Hogwood trying to secure a 4th consecutive season in the Premier League, interestingly his last stay in the Premier League ended in the 3rd season. His opponent Sandeep Chohan is trying to avoid dropping straight back down to the Championship his last stay in the Premier also only lasted a season with immediate relegation. A positive result in this match will guarantee safety in the Premier League as amazingly Steve Haley and Dan Wyatt face each other the two managers immediately out of the Relegation zone in trouble. Haley versus Wyatt is another winner takes all clash, with the victor guaranteed to stay in the Premier League. Dan Wyatt was only promoted last season trying to stay in the Premier League after 7 seasons in the Championship. Haley has been in the Premier League for 4 seasons qualifying for the Super20 Cup the first two seasons.

4 out of the 10 fixtures have something riding on them.

Jonathan Strack occupies the last promotion place and is hoping to get his first promotion to the Premier League moving from Pyramid One in 2011. Victory over Hakan Bedir would secure Promotion, Bedir though needs to win to stay up or avoid a massive defeat. Darren Cullen needs Strack to lose or draw and for him to beat Michael Carleton, Carleton has nothing to play for. A win for Cullen and a draw for Strack would see Cullen promoted due to the big point advantage he holds. If Cullen could gain promotion it would be a successive promotion and see him rise from Pyramid Two in 2012 to the top flight.

Hakan Bedir as stated takes on Promotion chasing Strack who needs victory to hold onto that last promotion place. Bedir can potentially lose but needs to avoid a heavy defeat and for Jeff Aldersea or Rio McLister to not have too big a win. For Bedir to go down it will take a 40-point swing in points difference. Jeff Aldersea takes on Kojo Amofa who has taken the Championship title, Aldersea needs a big victory and for Bedir to lose fairly heavily. Relegation will be a bit of a catastrophe for Aldersea he has been in the game for 13 seasons and has never been below the Championship. Rio McLister a season on from dropping out of the promotion places for the Premier League on the

last day of the season last season is now trying to stay up on the last day. McLister is on the same points as Aldersea but has an even worse points difference if Bedir loses an Aldersea wins Rio will need a massive victory over Joe Higgins the already promoted manager who is also in the New Life Cup final so he has a lot to play for. If Rio was to be relegated it will be an end of a two season stay in the Championship one which saw him just miss out on promotion followed by relegation.

Darrell Jenkins has secured promotion straight back to the Championship now he is hoping to add the League One title he faces Raymond Turp who needs a victory to stay in League One. Jenkins has a far superior points difference to his title rival Jatin Joshi. Joshi knows that he really needs to win his match and hope that Jenkins loses. Joshi takes on Pasquale Egisto who is chasing Promotion on this final day and is also in the Champions League final. Joshi will be happy that he has secured a successive promotion to get to his highest League the Championship moving from Pyramid Premier in 2011.

Andy McLaren is the highest manager yet to confirm promotion. McLaren knows that victory would secure promotion. He takes on Stephen Wilson who has nothing to play for. Promotion for McLaren would see him return to the Championship after two seasons in League One, McLaren has been in the Championship twice getting relegated straight away both times. McLaren is in a position knowing that if he does lose that two results go his way; he will be promoted regardless. Also point difference is puts him in a good position against 6th placed Tony Collins. Davdi Pewtner is in 4th place also yet to confirm promotion, Pewtner is only two points clear of 6th so he knows he really needs a victory over the already relegated Graham Price. With 6th place playing 7th place a positive result in this match would see one of those managers leapfrogging him Pewtner would need Pete Cuckson to lose and Pasquale Egisto to lose if he lost. If Pewtner can claim promotion it will a successive promotion. Pete Cuckson occupies the final promotion places on the same points as 6th. He will take on Steve Whitely who has nothing to play for. Cuckson though is in a precarious position as if he was to lose with 6th place playing 7th place a positive result in this match would see one of those managers leapfrogging him for 5th. Cuckson is trying to get out of League One after 3 seasons in the league. Tony Collins in 6th place on same points as 5th takes on Matt Hansell in 7th place both can gain promotion with victory in this match. If Cuckson or Pewtner lose the winner of this match will be promoted, victory has to be secured first for Hansell or Collins. Collins is trying to get out of League One in at the second attempt. Matt Hansell has been in League One for four seasons receiving a lucky survival in 2017 he has never been above League One. Pasquale Egisto is the last manager who has a chance of promotion, Egisto takes on Jatin Joshi who is trying to win the title so a tough match for Egisto who not only needs victory but needs both Pewtner and Cuckson to lose or a draw in the Collins Hansell match. Egisto also has the Champions League Final and is trying to secure a promotion in every season he has been in the game receiving one lucky promotion in 2017.

Adam Pemberton who is one of the most successful managers in the game with five major trophies, although the last one came in 2009, he is now just 1 point above the relegation zone. Adam takes on Daragh Prendergast who has nothing to play for. Adam is trying to avoid a 3rd successive promotion. Adam will stay up if he loses and Raymond Turp cannot win. Raymond takes on Darrell Jenkins who is chasing the title. A draw would not be good enough for Turp as although it would put him on the same points as Pemberton his points difference is far worse than Pemberton's. Turp is also trying to avoid successive relegations.

Tracy Thompson sits top of the league but know defeat could see her lose the title. Tracy takes on Hans Hayrynen who is fighting for promotion. Hans needs Drona to lose or draw then to beat title chasing Thompson to claim promotion. Tracy is seeking a successive promotion albeit that last seasons from the Conference was a lucky one finishing in 6th. The only manager who can take the title away from Tracy is James Bastow. Bastow is playing Sebastian Logan who has an outside chance of promotion but must beat Bastow to stand any chance. Bastow knows if he can win on the last day and Thompson slips up he will claim the title on points difference. Bastow's promotion sees him get out of League Two after 5 season if he can claim the title it will be his second super20 league title winning Pyramid Premier in 2013.

Drona Nandoe is in the last promotion place he is just 1 point clear, knowing that victory over David Bardon, who has nothing to play for, will give him promotion. Nandoe looking to gain promotion after two seasons in League Two. Hans Hayrynen is hoping that Drone loses or draws so that he can take advantage, Hans knows that really with other managers behind him he really needs victory of title chasing Tracy Thompson. Hans is looking to get out of League Two at the second attempt. Scott Smith needs both Nandoe and Hayrynen to lose, Smith takes on Andrew Ogden who has nothing to play for. Smith is a manager that has been promoted in his previous 3 seasons claiming two titles on the way so will be hoping to gain that last promotion place. David Noel needs the three managers above him to lose and beat the already relegated Lee Pepper. Noel also needs a 78-point difference swing in his favour to gain promotion. IF this miracle were to happen Noel would be claiming a 3rd successive

promotion. If Noel is hoping for a miracle the last manager that stands a chance of promotion Sebastian Logan needs divine intervention. He needs all the managers above him to lose then needs a point difference swing of 302 which would be quite amazing. To make matters worse Logan faces Bastow who is chasing the title on the final day. If the miracle of all miracles were to happen it would bring an end to 8 seasons in League Two for Logan.

Aubrey Davis sits just outside the Relegation zone 1 point above the drop he is taking on Steven McIntosh on the final day, McIntosh has already secured promotion. Davis really needs victory to ensure survival. Davis has finished bottom of League Two the last two season and has received lucky survivals he is hoping to survive by right this season. David Bardon is the managers who is just a point behind he needs to beat Drona Nandoe who i=needs a win to gain promotion. Bardon received a lucky survival last season in League Two. Steve Martin needs both Davis and Bardon to lose and to then beat the already relegated Dan Varrow to survive. Martin is trying to avoid successive relegations.

Alfie Harris is in the driving seat in the title race. Harris knows if he can win against already relegated Rob Wills it will be a first Super20 league title after finishing 2nd in his previous two seasons. Marc Bolton needs Alfie Harris to lose then beat Amanteer Singh, who needs victory himself chasing promotion, although Bolton and Harris will be on the same points total Bolton has a far superior points difference. Bolton like Harris has been promoted every season he has been in the game but is looking for his second Super20 title winning Pyramid One in 2017.

Dipesh Gamanial sitting in 3rd place is 3 points clear of 6th and has a decent points difference so should be okay but to be sure he needs to beat Steve Clarricoats who whilst has nothing to play for in Conference he is in the Champions League final. Dipesh like Harris and Bolton is trying to secure a promotion in each of his seasons in the game he did receive a lucky promotion in his first season. Amanteer Singh is in 4th and has a difficult final day match against title Marc Bolton, Singh is 3 points clear but does not have as good a points difference as Dipesh, so Singh really needs victory to ensure his promotion. Singh is another manager trying to secure a promotion for every season he has been in the game he received a lucky promotion last season. Stelios Andreou is the most vulnerable position holding the last promotion place but is only a point above 6th. Andreou needs victory against David Mahony who has nothing to play for. Stelios is hoping to gain promotion after 4 seasons in the Conference. Dan Couch in 6th plays already relegated Nick Balancy, if Couch can win he needs Andreou to lose to go up, if Gamanial or Singh lose it will come down to points difference which Couch is looking good on. Couch looking for promotion in his second season in the Conference. Dean Santoro in 7th place is the manager that needs the most things to go his way he needs Couch and Andreou to lose if that happens if he can beat the already Gary Dodds he will secure promotion. Dean has received two lucky promotions in the last two seasons his only seasons in the game he is hoping for a hat-trick of promotions.

Kelly is looking for a 3rd successive promotion the first being a lucky one and will have been promoted in every season he has been in the game. Daniel Sherry needs a victory to be sure of promotion he is just 2 points clear of 6th. Sherry takes on Marcus Hogwood who has survived due to the fixture list on the final day. Sherry will be promoted if Adrian Comer doesn't win on the last day of the season. Sherry is going for 3rd successive promotion also to be promoted every season he has been in the game. Adrian Comer in in 6th place 2 points off promotion and 3 off 4th place but with a superior points difference if results go his way victory against Owen Gredley who has nothing to play for. Comer is going for a 3rd successive promotion last season receiving a lucky promotion he is another manager that has been promoted every season he has been in the game.

Daniel Hansen takes on Jonathon Kelly who is going for promotion, Hansen knows that he can lose narrowly due to the fixtures and stay up to be sure he needs victory. Hansen is trying to stay in the Pyramid Premier for a 4th season. Nikki Ogden takes on Kin Chau in what is almost a relegation play-off, who ever wins will stay up. If Ogden was to lose, she will need Daniel Hansen to be beaten by a big margin to have a hope of staying up. For Kin victory keeps him safe defeat sees him relegated. For Ogden relegation will see her go straight back down after a season in the Pyramid Premier. For Kin relegation will bring an end of 4 seasons in the Pyramid Premier. Paren Arzoomanian takes on Martin Stuart who has nothing to play for in the league but is in the New Life Cup final. Arzoomanian will have one eye on that Ogden V Chau match needing an Ogden victory if he can't beat Stuart. Relegation will see Arzoomanian relegated in first season in the Pyramid Premier.
